



After School Program

The final bell rings but the day is far from over - you're still at work and your child is looking for something fun to do. Cue Imagine!'s After School Program! Qualified Counselors and Therapeutic Specialists pick up your loved one from school and the fun begins! The afternoon consists of a wide range of therapeutic activities and lesson plans to engage participants of all abilities in learning, gaining skills, becoming more independent, and making new friends. Activities include: bowling, swimming, arts and crafts, theater production, field trips, and much more!

How it works..

<u>Pick up</u>

Your loved one is picked up from school by an Imagine! Counselor and driven to the designated activity with the rest of their peers and Counselors.

Participants arrive at activity

and get settled in: eat snack, use restroom, say hi to peers, go for walk, etc. Then, the activity and fun begins! Work with staff to engage in designated activity and work toward goals as outlined in participant's Individualized Plan.

Transition Home

The activity is complete and it is time to say goodbye to peers, gather belongings, use restroom one last time, and head to an Imagine! vehicle.

End of Day

Participants are driven to one of three respective base sites in Boulder County to meet up with parents/family member. Participants are signed out of the program and it's time to go home!

Summer Camp

Imagine!'s Summer Camp is 10 weeks of growing, learning, and adventure! Summer Camp typically begins the beginning of June and runs through the second week of August. Camp is offered Monday through Friday from 8:30am until 5:00pm. Imagine! Summer Camp uses three sites in the community that serve as "basesites" for pick-ups and drop-offs. Camp activities take place at recreational facilities, local parks, and public venues in Boulder County and Denver. Our wide variety of FUN activities include swimming, adaptive sports and games, arts and crafts, fishing, tours of museums and local landmarks, and field trips to sites such as amusement parks, water parks, National Parks, zoos, and much more! Transportation is provided during the 8-hour service.

Based on school district calendars for Boulder Valley, St. Vrain, and Adams 12, Imagine! offers an eight hour day of programming to students ages 7-21. Ice skating, arts and crafts, bowling, movement and dance, the aquarium... you name it! These funpacked days will engage your child in meaningful and exciting activities to foster growth and independence. Safe transportation, small participant to counselor ratios, weather appropriate activities, and updated behavior plans ensure a successful day for all. Our Certified Therapeutic Recreation Specialists organize quality lesson plans and schedule outings at accessible locations all across the Boulder and Denver region.

WHAT IS THERAPEUTIC RECREATION?

Therapeutic Recreation (TR) is an allied health profession which focuses on improving a person's quality of life in the following five domains: physical, cognitive, social, emotional, and spiritual, with an emphasis on leisure needs through activity interventions. Imagine! uses community based Therapeutic Recreation in all of our School Age Services, using the community as our classroom and teaching daily living skills and independence with real life scenarios. Imagine!'s team of Recreation Therapists (CTRS) help ensure that the principles of TR are infused into each lesson plan and, ultimately, the fabric of what we do.

WHAT WE DO:

- 1) We promote and support community inclusion.
- 2) We provide opportunities for learning and growth.
- We offer individualized learning opportunities through meaningful and challenging activities and classes.
- We promote participants' health, safety, and well-being.
- 5) We emphasize strengths, abilities, and positive individual choices.
- We provide services that benefit participants and their families.

Join us for the second annual Community Art Show and experience firsthand the inspirational and original artwork created by participants in Imagine! School Age Services.


